The amount of the scholarship for the 2022-2023 academic year is \$750.00

Eligibility Requirements:

To be considered for a scholarship, the graduating senior must:

- A. Be a current year graduating senior.
- B. Be eligible for admission, have submitted an application, and have been accepted into a university, college, trade school or military academy no later than the fall semester of 2023.
- C. Each applicant will complete the scholarship packet. The completed packet must be returned to Mrs. Galeana, high school counselor or to Mrs. Holly McCall, the high school registrar.
- D. Completed applications must be returned to the Counselor's Office no later than Wednesday, April 19, 2023.**

All decisions and selections of the Randolph Field Education Foundation Senior Scholarship Committee will be final.
